Training

- Detailed insight into the clinical trial process
- IRB, HIPAA and Common Rule regulations for clinical research
- Extraction and interpretation of patient-relevant information from clinical trial protocols
- The process of patient approach and screening for clinical trial eligibility

Responsibilities

- Utilizing the Modern Trials platform to search EMR data for patients who may benefit from particular clinical trial opportunities
- Helping to ensure adherence to IRB, HIPAA and Common Rule guidelines
- Patient outreach and screening per trial inclusion and exclusion criteria
- Following and providing feedback on the patient approach and screening protocol
