

Dear Student:

With the loss of the apartment building that once housed the medical students, we have researched extensively all viable lodging opportunities. Our main goal was to ensure your stay would be convenient, comfortable, safe and clean. We visited extended stay hotels, as well as several companies that offer temporary living arrangements for travelers who are spending weeks or even months in Columbus. As a result, Doctors Hospital OhioHealth has teamed up with Temporary Living of Columbus and Corporate Housing Systems to offer you the best lodging accommodations Columbus has to offer. We are also pleased to be able to extend to the student financial assistance by paying 50% of your daily rate should you decide to lodge with these selected companies.

Initially, you may feel that you just can't afford the expense, but actually the amount for a 4 week stay will be equal to, or even less than 1 month's rent for a nice apartment or home. In return, you will be staying in a fully furnished, updated, clean apartment that is located in a residential neighborhood and is close to shopping and easy access to the highway and the hospital.

In addition, you will notice you have the option of a 1 or 2 bedroom apartment. If you prefer, you can choose to share the apartment with another student, thus reducing your expense even more. The cost would be divided between you and your fellow student and billed separately.

Please review the information contained in this packet and make the appropriate contact to fit your needs. You will not be required to sign a rental agreement, however, you will be required to sign a reservation confirmation (sample enclosed) and credit card authorization. It is suggested you make sure you have some form of renters insurance, either under your existing policy, or your parents homeowner's policy.

Please note, these properties are available on a first come-first serve basis. All of the properties have ample parking, exercise facilities, most have an indoor or outdoor pool and you can also request housekeeping services for an additional charge.
