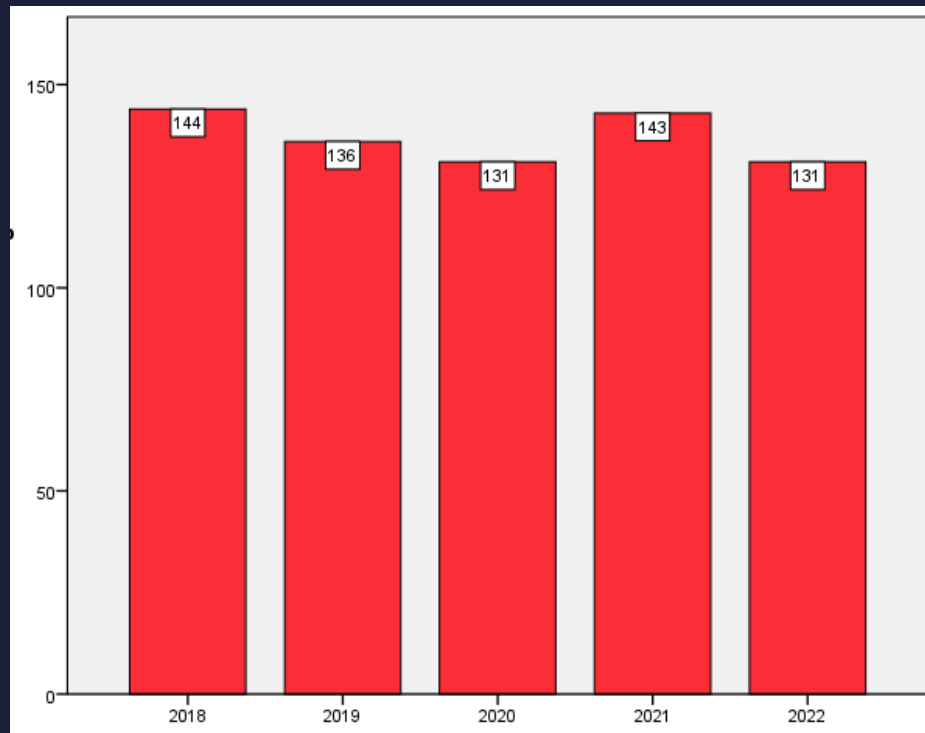

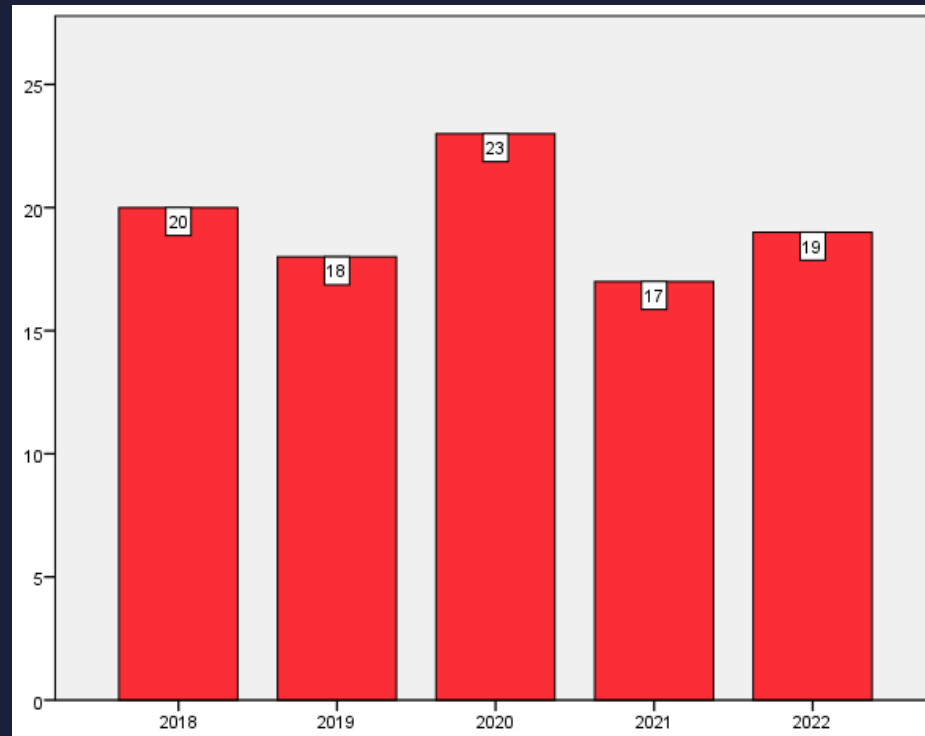
Number of Pennsylvania Residents in the

Cumulative GPA



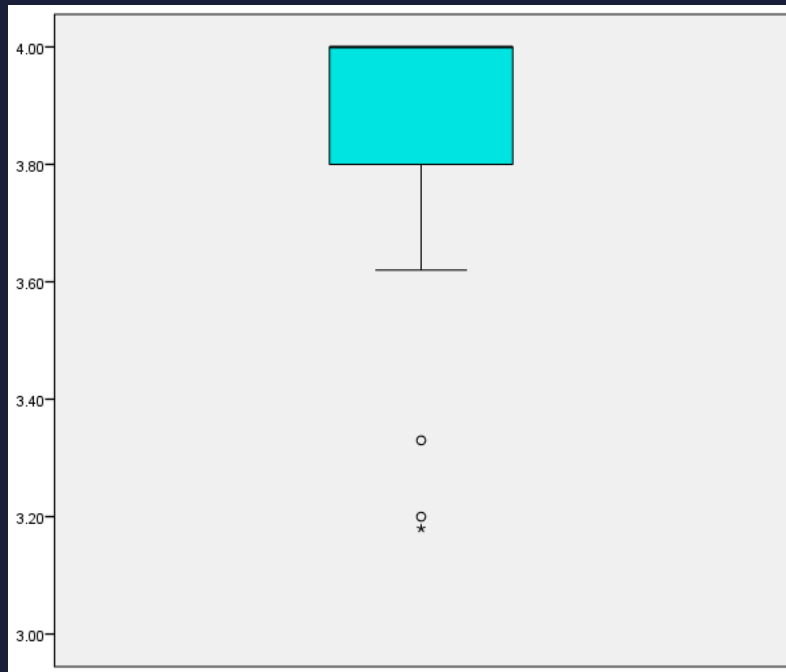

Cumulative GPA



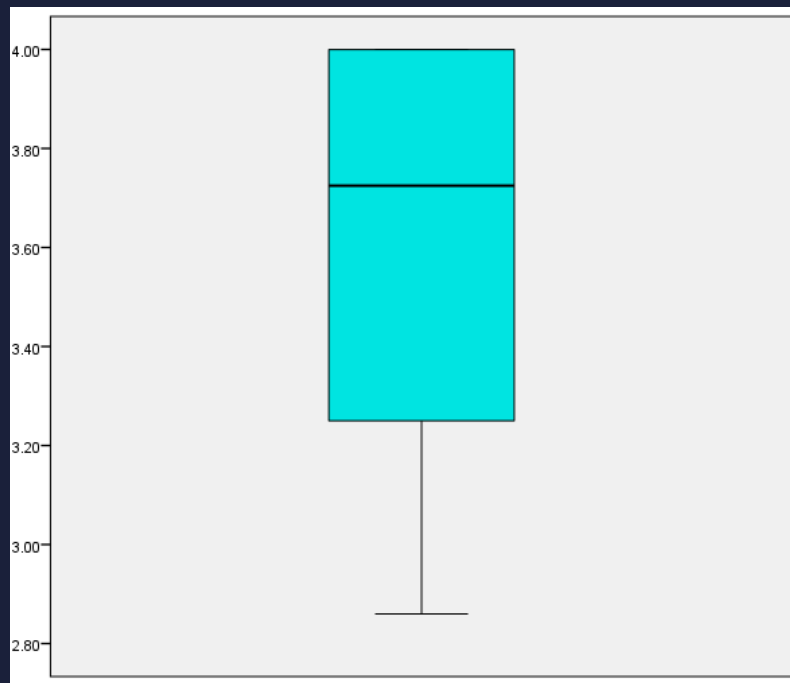

Undergraduate Cumulative GPA



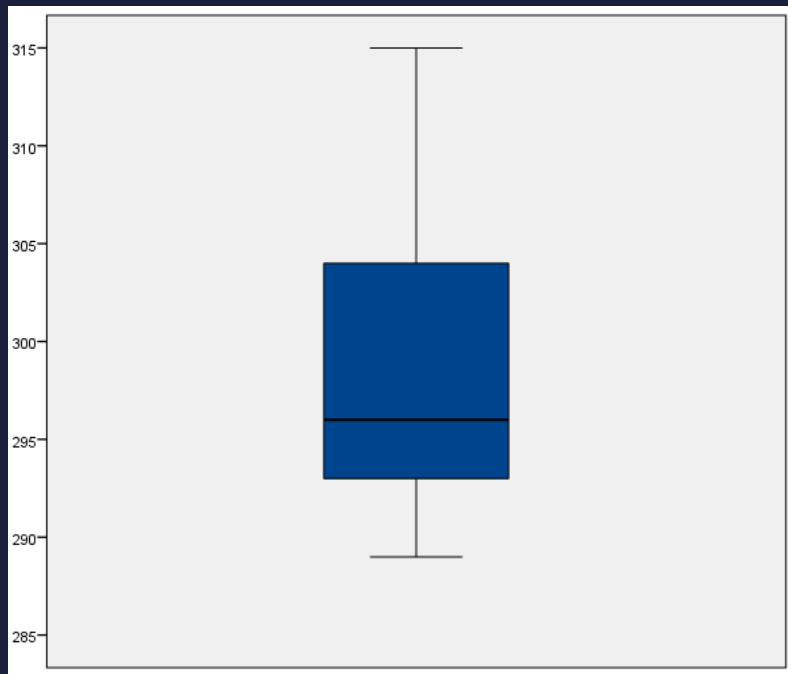

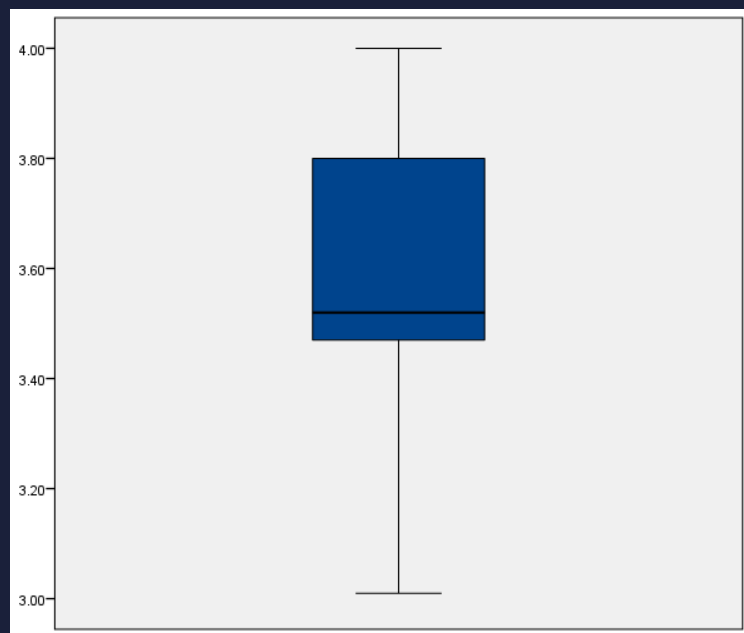
Cumulative GPAs Combined
