SUBJECT: Revised Policy for Active Duty Health Professions/Financial Assistance
Program Stipend and Annual Grant Amount

Effective 1 September 2007, the monthly stipend for the F. Edward Hébert Armed Forces Health Professions Scholarship/Financial Assistance Program (AFHPSP/FAP) participants for the Fiscal Year 07-08 school year will increase from \$1,349 per month to \$1,605 per month. The annual grant for FAP participants will remain at the current \$28,454.

For planning purposes, the stipend and grant amounts for the FY08-09 school year, to become effective on July 1, 2008, will be as follows:

- Stipend: \$1,907 per month
- FAP Annual Grant: \$45,000
