

# iPhone 2.0 or Higher Setup & Configuration

## OUHSC Campus Email

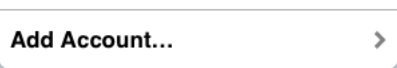
Only version 2 or higher of the Apple iPhone operating system supports native integration with the OUHSC campus email system (i.e., Microsoft Exchange).



1. Select **Settings** from the Main Menu

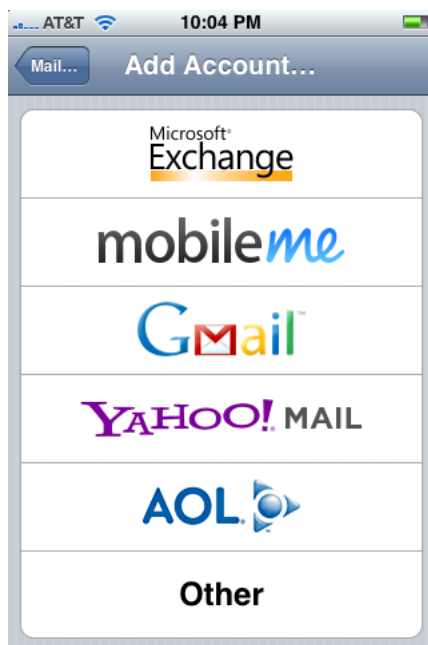


2. Select **Mail, Contacts, Calendars**



3. Select **Add Account...**

4. From the **Add Account...** menu, select **Microsoft Exchange**



5. Complete the email setup with the following data:
  - **Email** *your OUHSC email address (i.e., firstname-lastname@ouhsc.edu)*
  - **Domain** *enter ouhsc*
  - **Username** *your OUHSC UserID*
  - **Password** *your OUHSC email password, and select Next*

6. If you receive an error notice stating that the iPhone is “unable to verify certificate,” select **Accept**.
7. A new **Server** field will be added to the screen with the default text *exchange.company.com*. Replace it with the following information:

<b>Server</b>	webmail.ouhsc.edu
---------------	-------------------

and select **Next**.

8. Three (3) components may be turned on by default:
  - **Mail** synchronizes your email messages from the OUHSC Exchange server
  - **Contacts** synchronizes your contacts from the OUHSC Exchange server
  - **Calendar** synchronizes your calendars from the OUHSC Exchange server
9. Select **Save**. The iPhone will notify you that it is synchronizing itself with Exchange, and the Exchange account will be added to your email account list.

## OUHSC Campus wireless (Optional)

The Apple iPhone can utilize both the public OU-Guest and the private OUBASE network when on the OUHSC campus.

**OU-Guest** – No setup is required on the Apple iPhone in order to utilize the public OU-Guest wireless network.

1. Verify that Apple iPhone Wi-Fi is turned on:



- a. Select from the Main Menu

- b. Select  **Wi-Fi** >

- c. Turn Wi-Fi **ON**

2. The iPhone should find OU-guest as an available wireless network
  - a. Depending on your personal settings, you may have to choose to join the network

**OUBASE** – Access to OUBASE requires special setup:

1. Verify that Apple iPhone Wi-Fi is turned on:




- a. Select **Settings** from the Main Menu
- b. Select **Wi-Fi**
- c. Turn Wi-Fi **ON**

2. Select **Other...** from the **Choose a Network...** section



3. Enter the following:

- a. **Name** *OUBASE*
- b. Select **Security** > **WPA Enterprise**
- c. Return to **Other Network** screen using navigation at the top of the screen
- d. **Username** *enter your OUHSC UserID*
- e. **Password** *enter your OUHSC email password*
