**2014-2015 PTCAS Applicant Data Report**

The 2014-15 PTCAS Applicant Data Report reflects the 17,587 applicants with mailed application status who applied via the Physical Therapist Centralized Application Service (PTCAS) during the 2014-15 (7th) admissions cycle. Applicants with mailed status submitted a total of 104,579 applications to the 180 physical therapist education programs participating in PTCAS.

The 2014-15 PTCAS admissions cycle opened on July 1, 2014 and closed on June 1, 2015. Participating programs submitted admission decisions to PTCAS through September 2015. PTCAS applicants with the following admission decisions were categorized as “accepted” for the purposes of this report: offer made, offer accepted, withdrew after offer accepted, declined offer, and deferred.

The number of mailed PTCAS applicants increased 4.5% and the number of applications increased 8.6% as compared to the 2013-14 admissions cycle. Applicants applied to an average of 5.9 programs in PTCAS versus 5.7 programs in the previous cycle.

Thirteen new programs joined PTCAS in 2014-15. Each new program in PTCAS resulted in an average of 54.6 new applicants and 594 new applications with mailed status.

Application data for the programs that participated in PTCAS during the 2013-14 and 2014-15 cycles:

- 56% experienced an increase in applications.
- 43% experienced a decrease in applications.
- 1% experienced no change in applications.

The mean percent change in the number of applications per program was 2.0%, the median was 3.8%, and the range was -54.1 % to 70.2%. Programs in PTCAS during the 2014-15 cycle may access program-specific reports via WebAdMIT through at least June 2017.

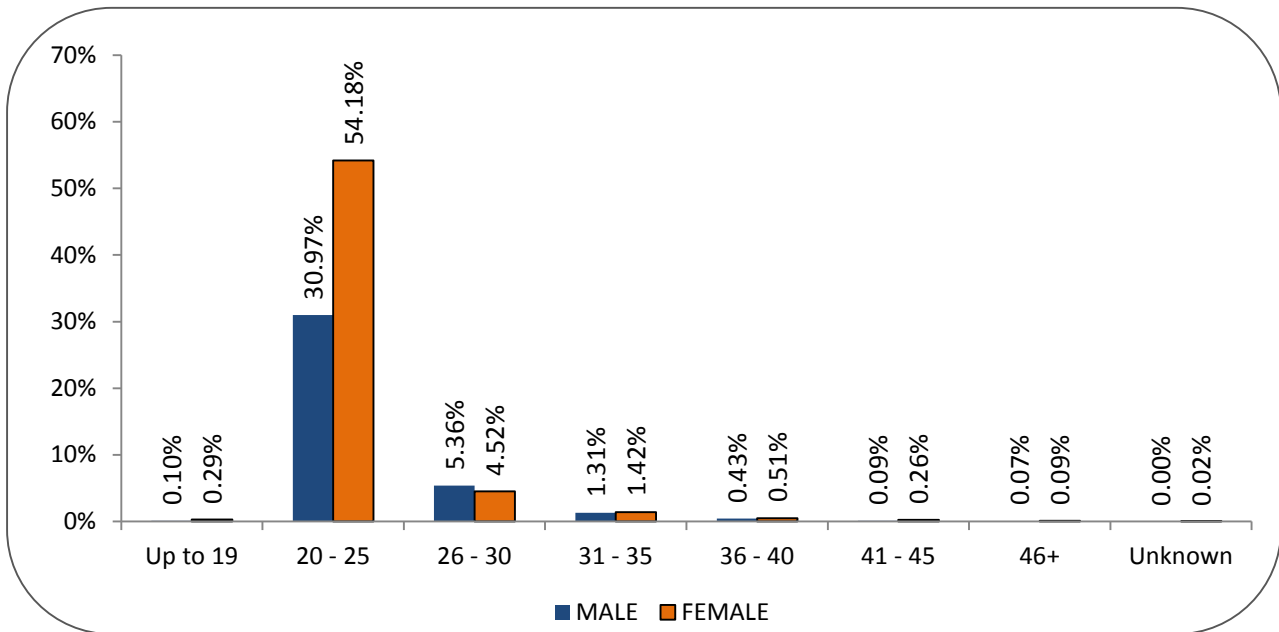

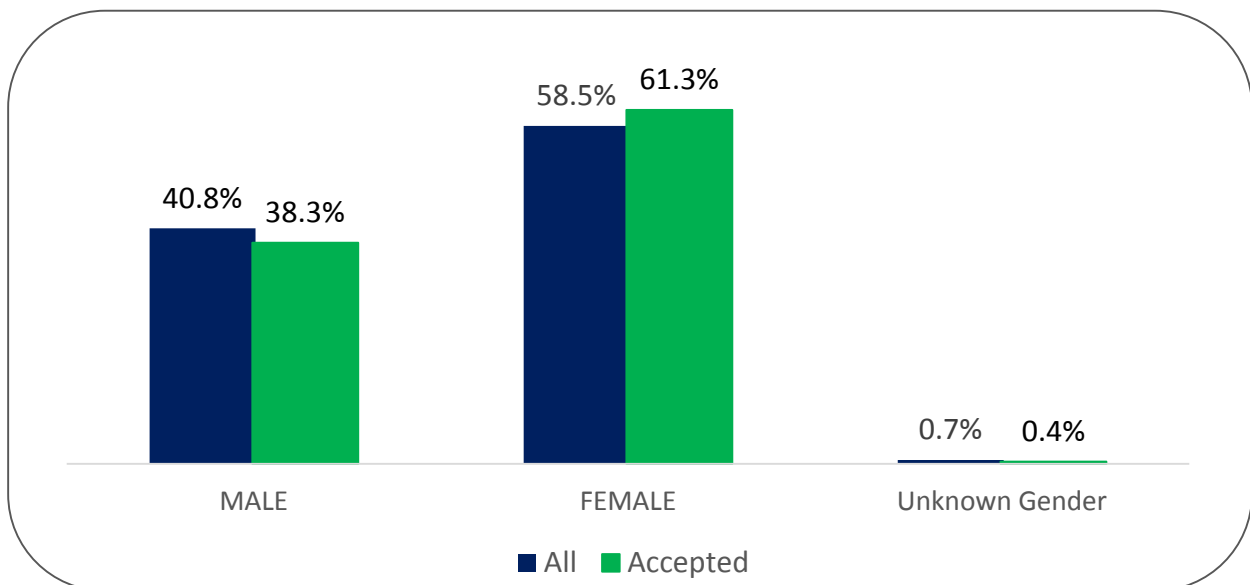

**Figure 2: Percent of PTCAS Applicants by Gender and Acceptance Status**

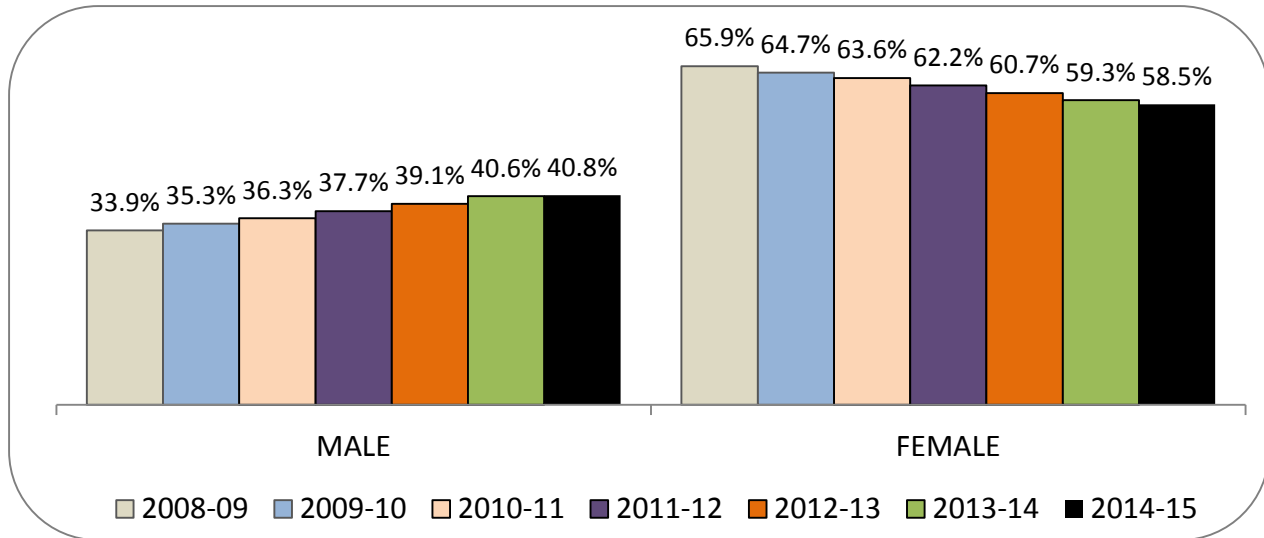

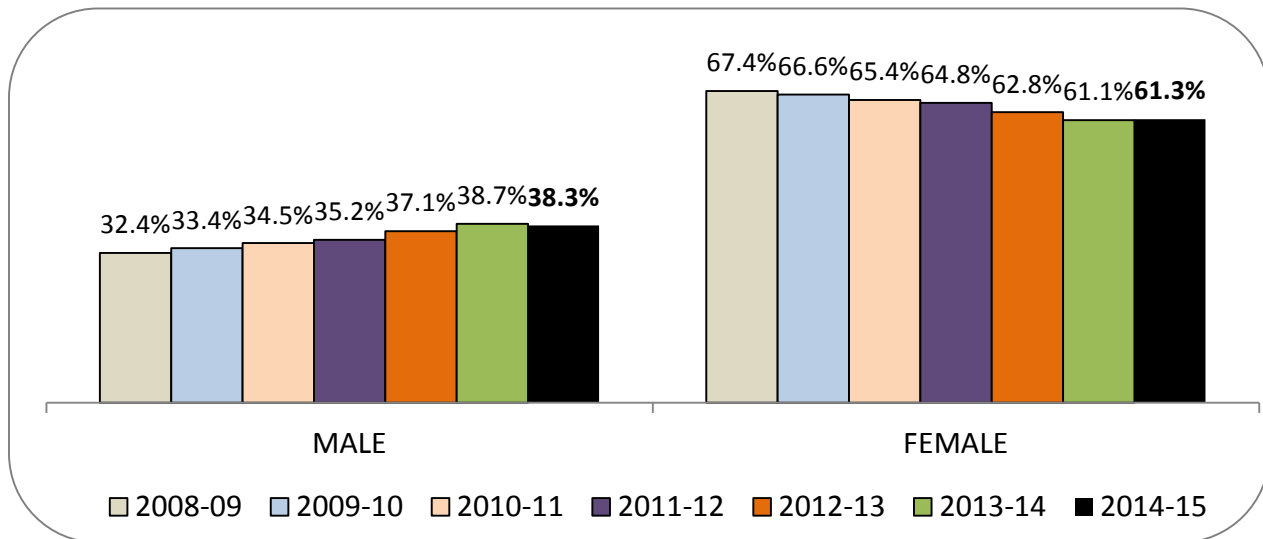
## Trends: Gender

The percent of male applicants who applied to programs in PTCAS increased by 0.2% in the 2014-15 admissions cycle, as compared to the previous cycle. The gender field on the PTCAS application includes a “decline to state” option. Less than 1 percent of PTCAS applicants selected “decline to state” for this item. These applicants are not reflected in the trend graphs below.

## Race/Ethnicity

During the 2008-09 (first) admissions cycle, applicants could select only one racial or ethnic category on the PTCAS application. Applicants in the 2009-10 (second) cycle could select one or more racial or ethnic categories, and the “Hispanic or Latino” category was moved to a separate field. The “other” racial and ethnic category was removed in the 2010-11 (third) PTCAS and re-added in the 2013-14 cycle.

Programs in PTCAS can view all of the racial and ethnic designations for each application received. For the purpose of this report only, applicants with multiple racial and ethnic categories selected are categorized as “2+ Race/Ethnicity Designations”. Review [table 6](#) to view data regarding the actual number of racial and ethnic category designations submitted by applicants. This report does not reflect applicants who applied to and were accepted by programs outside of PTCAS.

The following data reflect the number of applicants who self-identified as Hispanic or Latino:

- **762** applicants selected YES to the “race\_hispanic” field and YES to additional race fields.
- **594** applicants selected YES to the “race\_hispanic” field only and did not select additional race fields.

In tables 4-5 and figures 5-7 the number of “Hispanic/Latino” applicants reflects all applicants who self-identified as Hispanic or Latino, regardless of race selected. In previous report years Hispanic or Latino applicants who also selected a race were categorized under “Two+ Race/Ethnicity Designations”. Therefore, the number of Hispanic and Latino applicants appears to be significantly higher in the 2014-15 and 2013-14 reports, as compared to previous reports.

Seven out of eight programs at Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCU) participated in PTCAS in 2014-15.

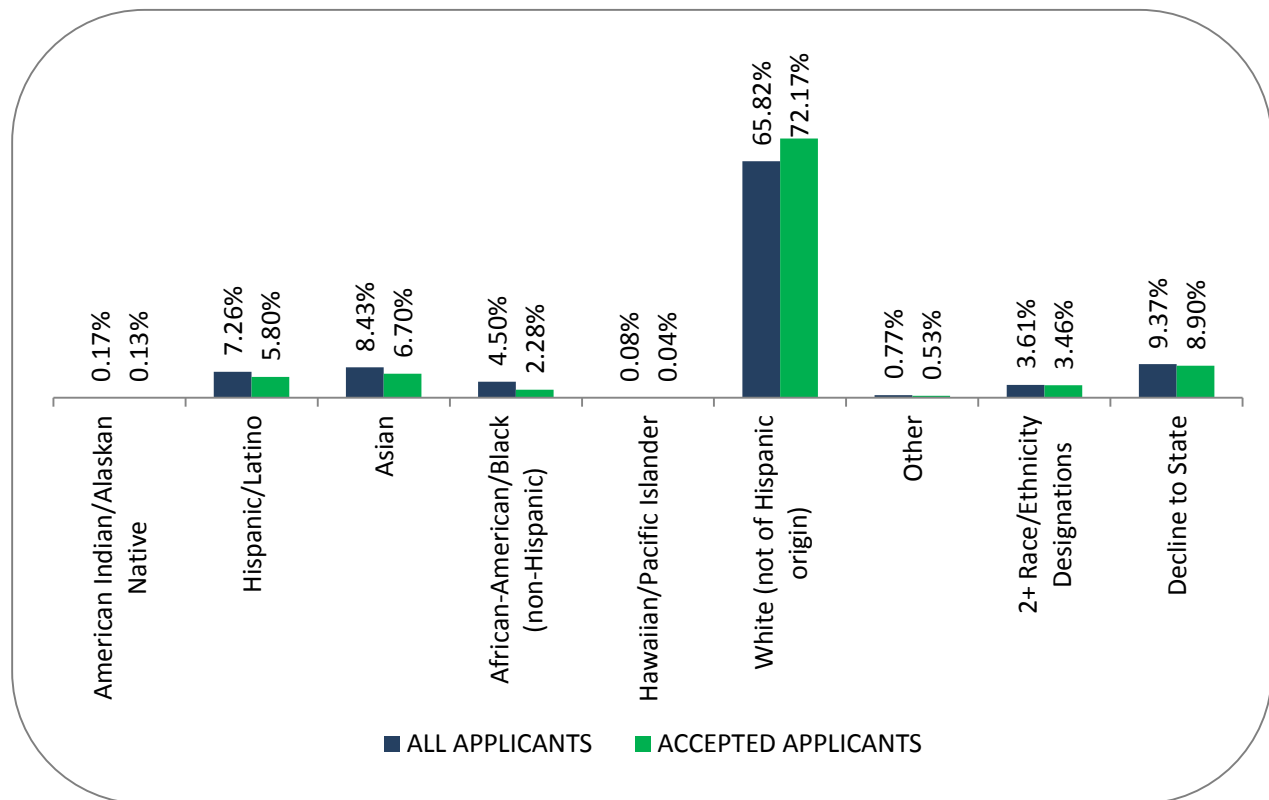

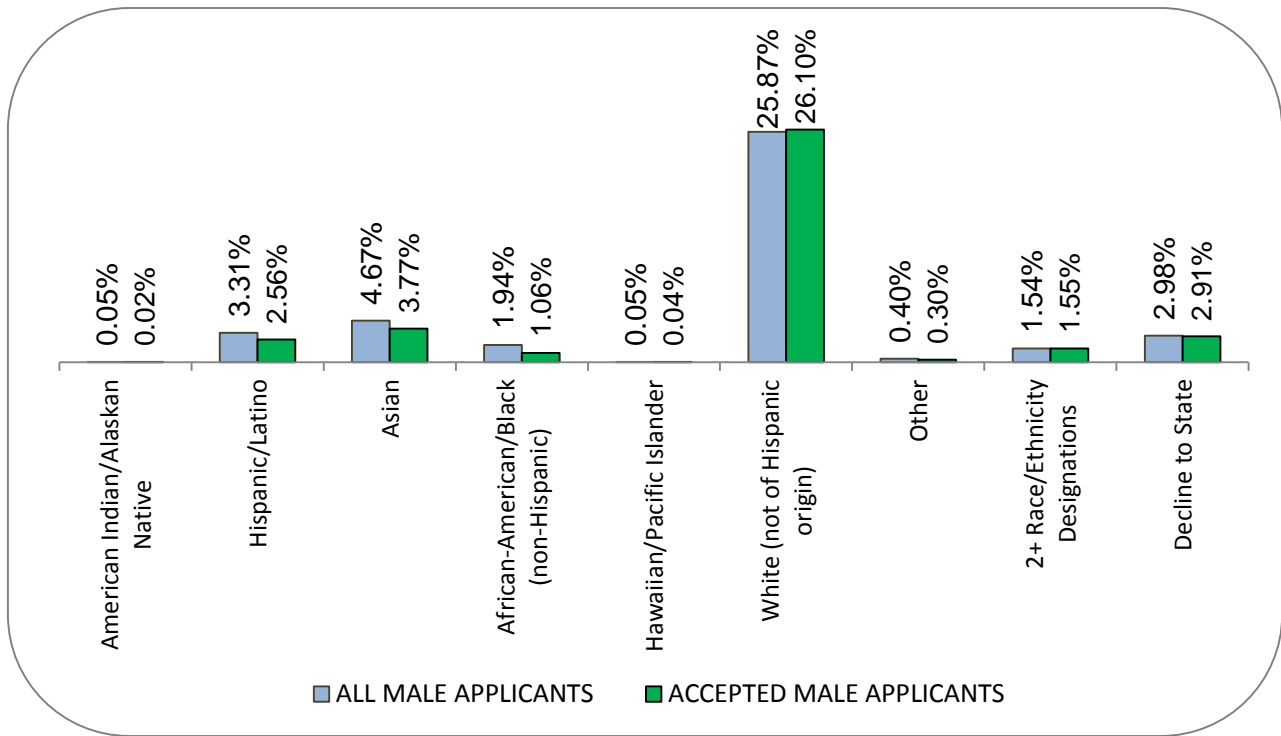
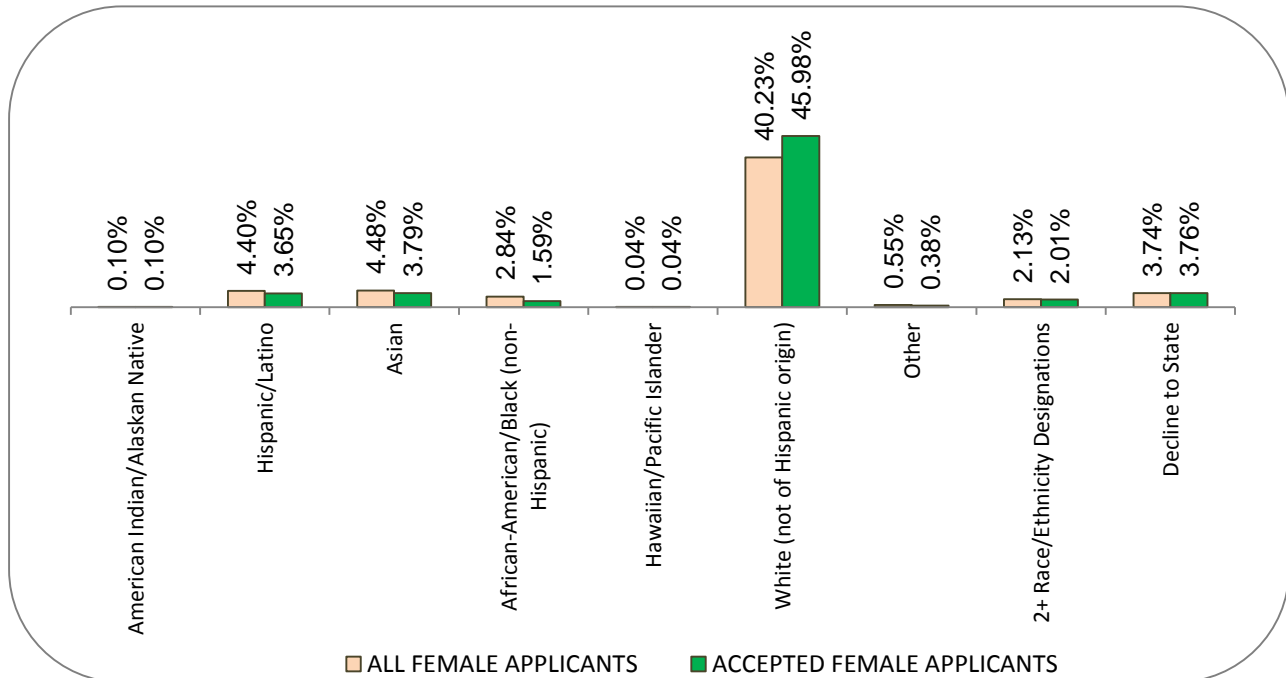

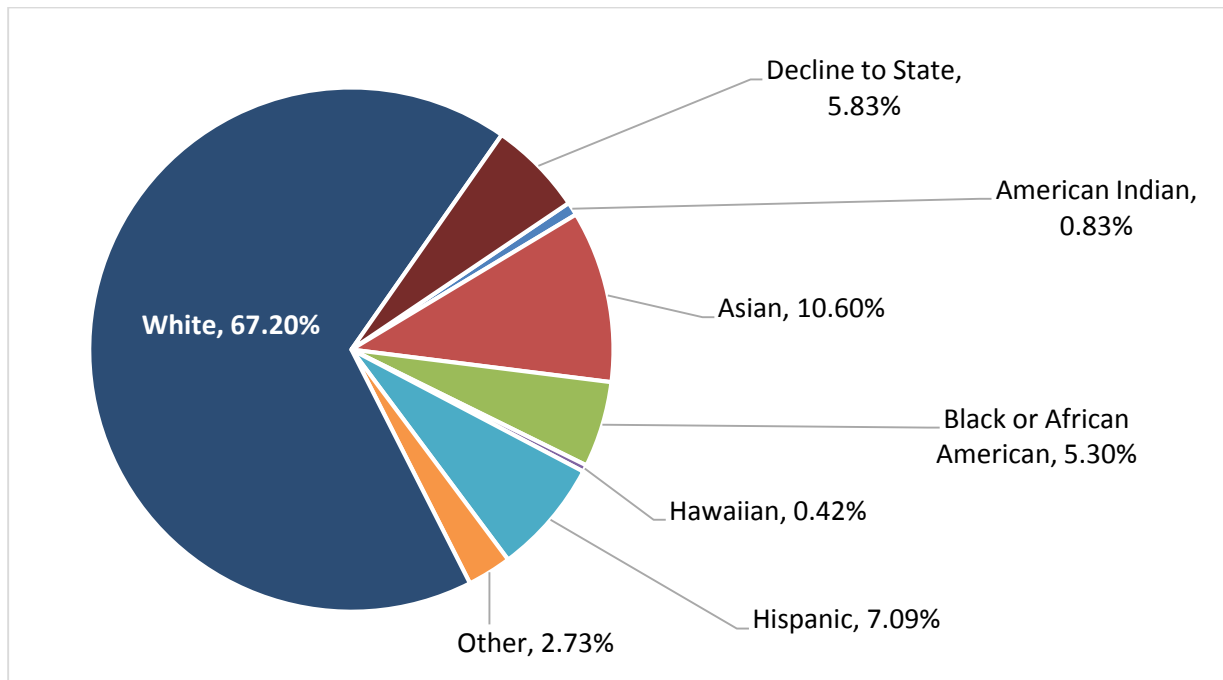
Figure 6: Percent of **MALE** PTCAS Applicants by Race/Ethnicity and Acceptance Status\*Figure 7: Percent of **FEMALE** PTCAS Applicants by Race/Ethnicity and Acceptance Status\*

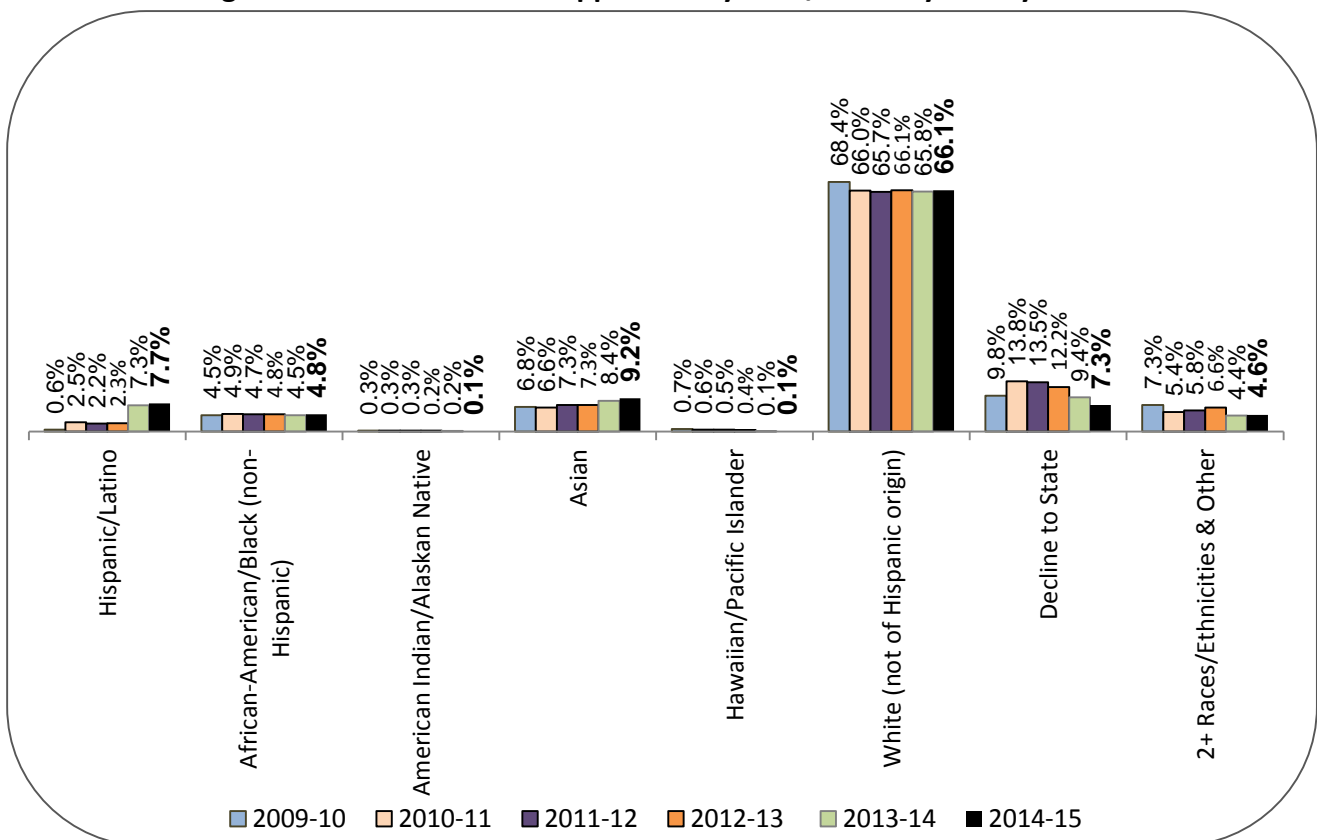
## Trends: Race/Ethnicity

During the 2008-09 (first) admissions cycle, applicants could select only one racial or ethnic category on the PTCAS application. Applicants in the 2009-10 (second) cycle could select one or more racial or ethnic categories, and the “Hispanic or Latino” category was moved to a separate field. The “other” racial and ethnic category was removed in the 2010-11 (third) PTCAS cycle and re-added in the 2013-14 cycle.

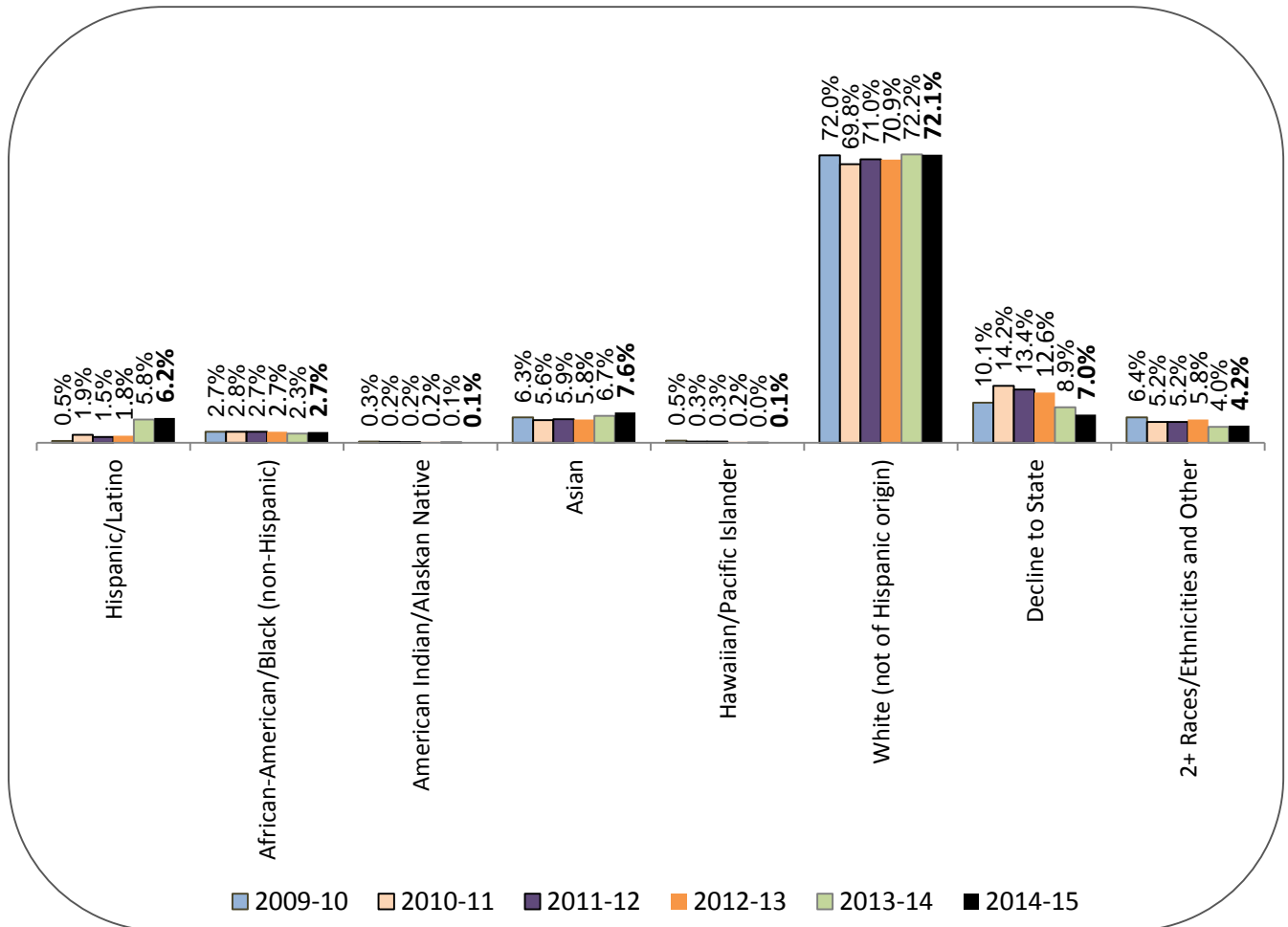
In tables 4-5 and figures 5-7 the number of “Hispanic/Latino” applicants reflects all applicants who self-identified as Hispanic or Latino. In the 2012-13 and previous reports Hispanic or Latino applicants who also selected a race were categorized under “Two+ Race/Ethnicity Designations”. Therefore, the number of Hispanic and Latino applicants appears to be significantly higher in the 2014-15 and 2013-14 reports, as compared to previous reports.

There were 762 applicants who selected YES to the “race\_hispanic” field and YES to additional race fields, and 594 applicants who selected YES to the “race\_hispanic” field only and did not select additional race fields. Based on [table 6](#) in this report, there were a total of **1,356** PTCAS applicants who designated “Hispanic/Latino” in the 2014-15 PTCAS application, as compared to 1,221 in 2013-14, 945 in 2012-13, 755 in 2011-12, 638 in 2010-11, 499 applicants in 2009-10, and 281 applicants in 2008-09. There were 510 “Hispanic/Latino” applicants accepted by one or more programs in PTCAS in 2014-15 versus 449 in 2013-14, 357 in 2012-13, 304 in 2011-12, 279 in 2010-11, 217 in 2009-10, and 115 in 2008-09.

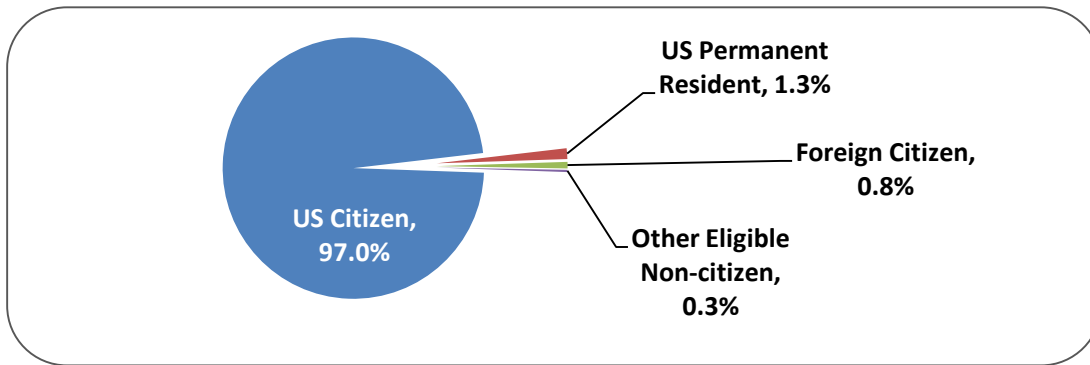
## Citizenship

The majority of PTCAS applicants were U.S. citizens: 97.0% (2014-15), 97.6% (2013-14), 97.4% (2012-13), 97.2% (2011-12), 96.9% (2010-11), 96.4% (2009-10), and 96.3% (2008-09). Other eligible noncitizen category includes the following immigration designations, as defined by the Department of Homeland Security: "Refugee," "Asylum Granted," "Indefinite Parole," "Humanitarian Parole," and "Cuban-Haitian Entrant".

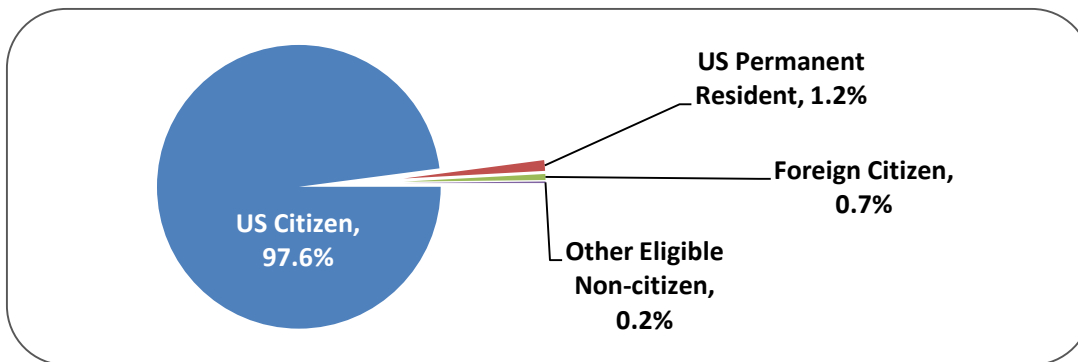

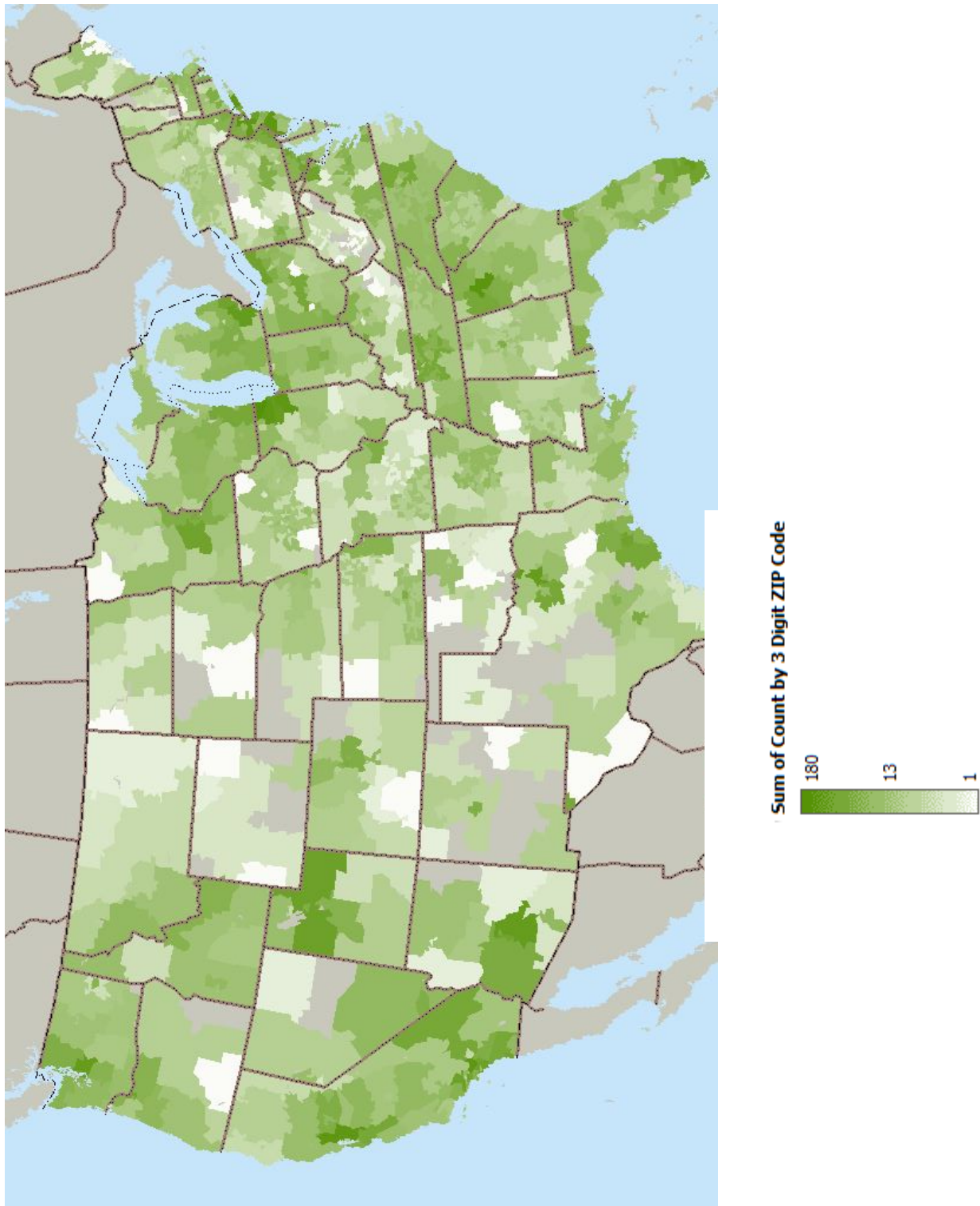

**Figure 12: Map of PTCAS Applicants in the United States by 3-Digit ZIP Code**





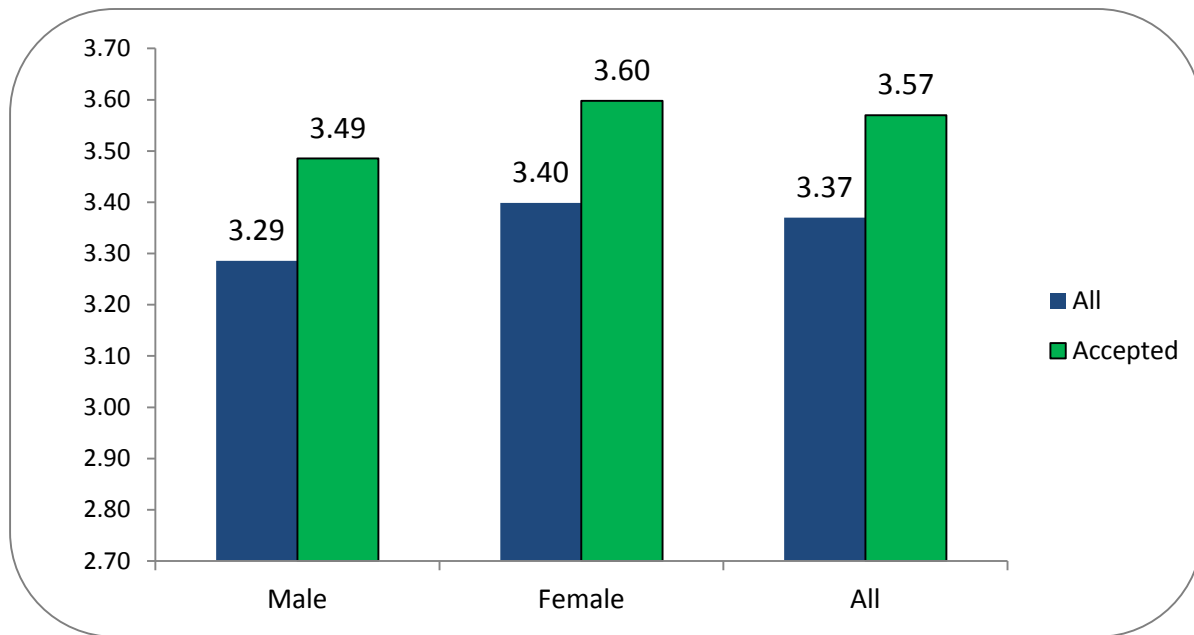
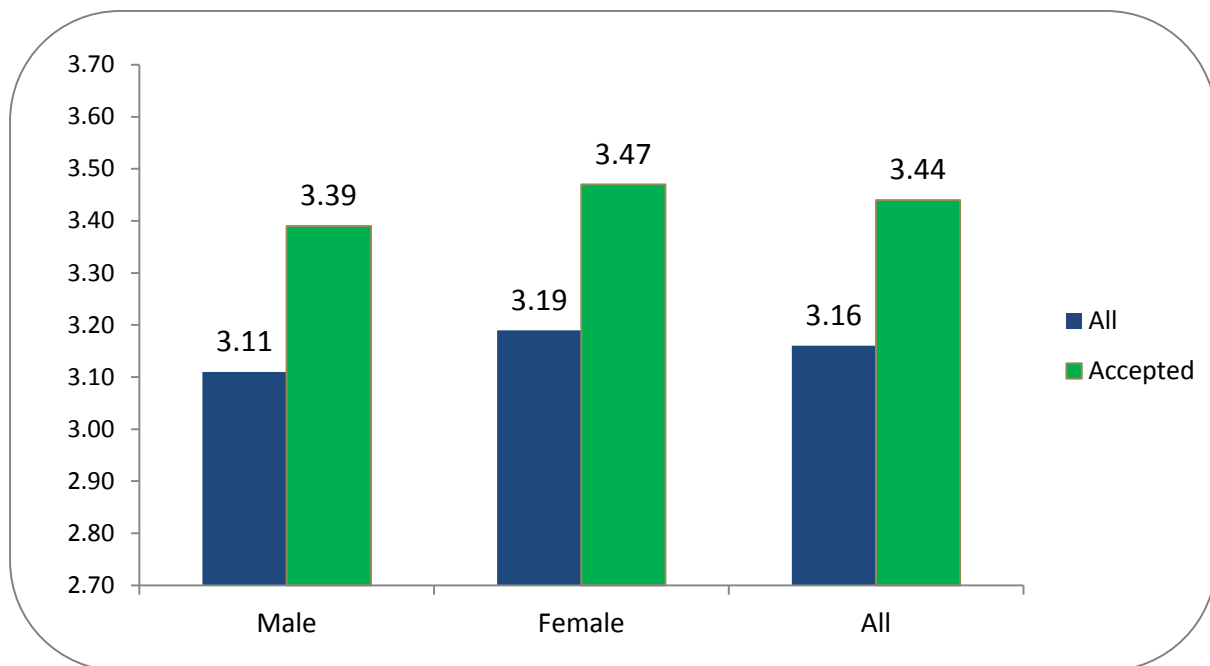
## Grade Point Averages (GPAs)

PTCAS calculates standardized grade point averages (GPAs) to help participating programs evaluate applicants using uniform and consistent criteria, regardless of different institutional transcript policies. The PTCAS GPAs are automatically generated by the system and are likely to be different from those calculated by the colleges and universities attended due to the PTCAS grade standardization process. PTCAS includes ALL initial AND **repeated** coursework in its GPA calculations; therefore, the average GPAs may be lower than the average GPAs calculated by a local PT education program. PTCAS calculates standardized GPAs using a semester-based 4.0 scale.

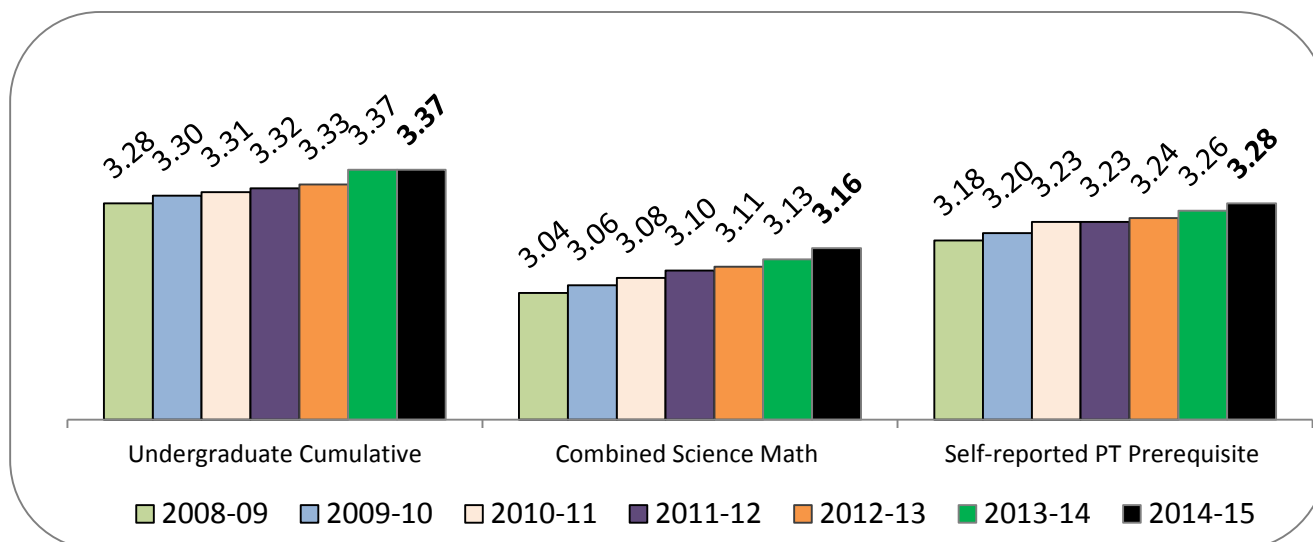

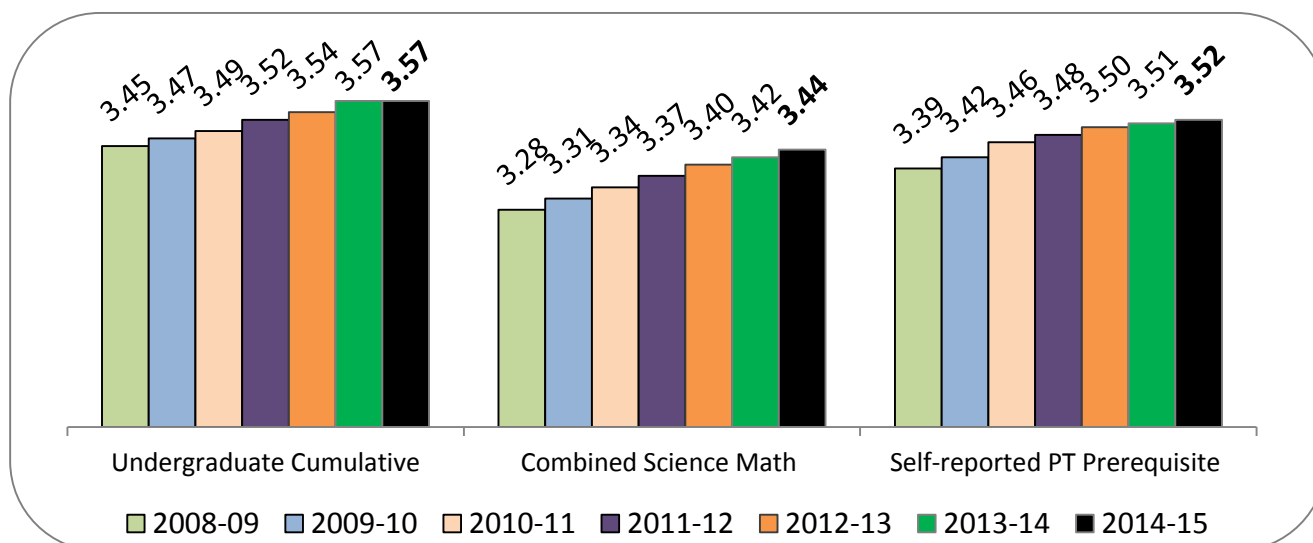

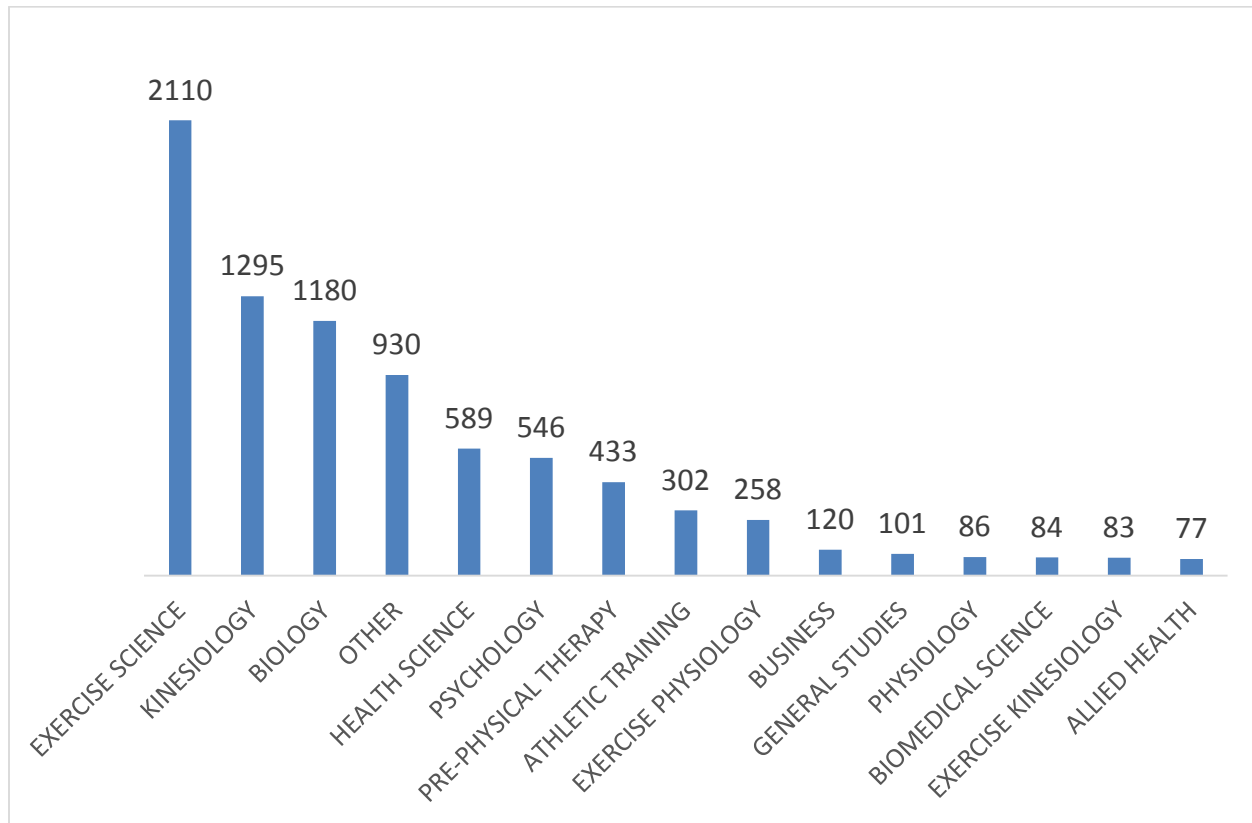

## Electronic Letters of Reference (eLORs)

A total of 47,042 evaluators submitted 63,268 electronic letters of reference (eLORs) to PTCAS during the 2014-15 admission cycle. Of these, 57,414 eLORs were associated with "mailed" PTCAS applicants. PTCAS did not accept paper references in the 2013-14 or 2014-15 cycles.

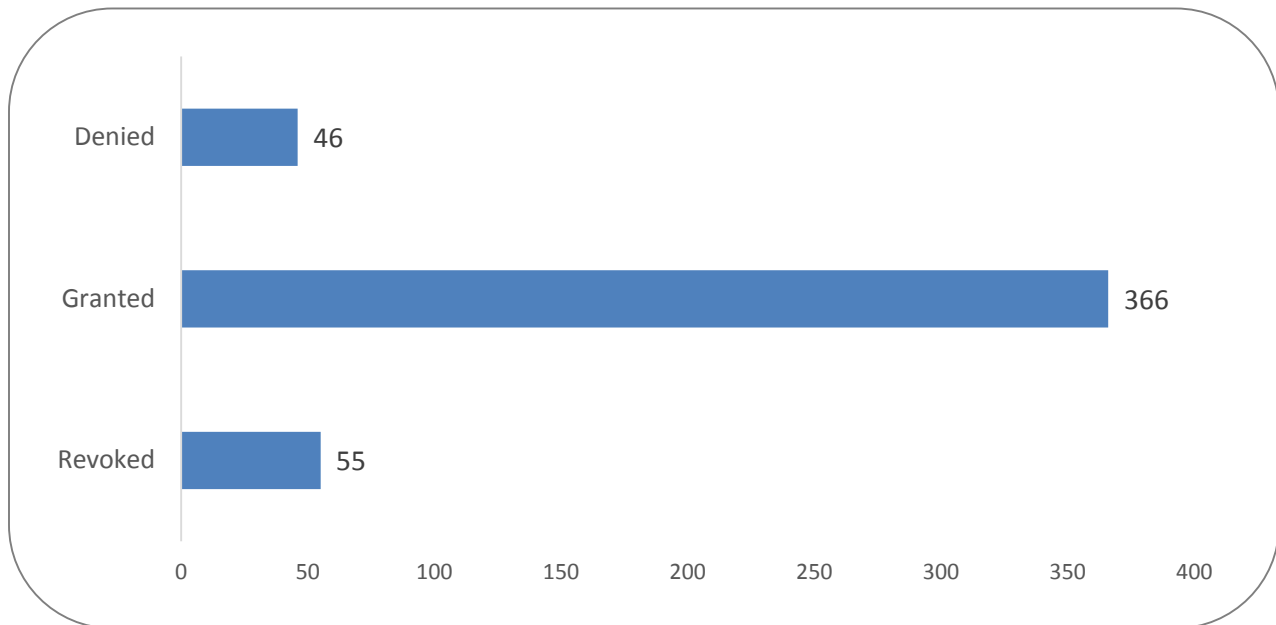
## PTCAS Fee Waivers

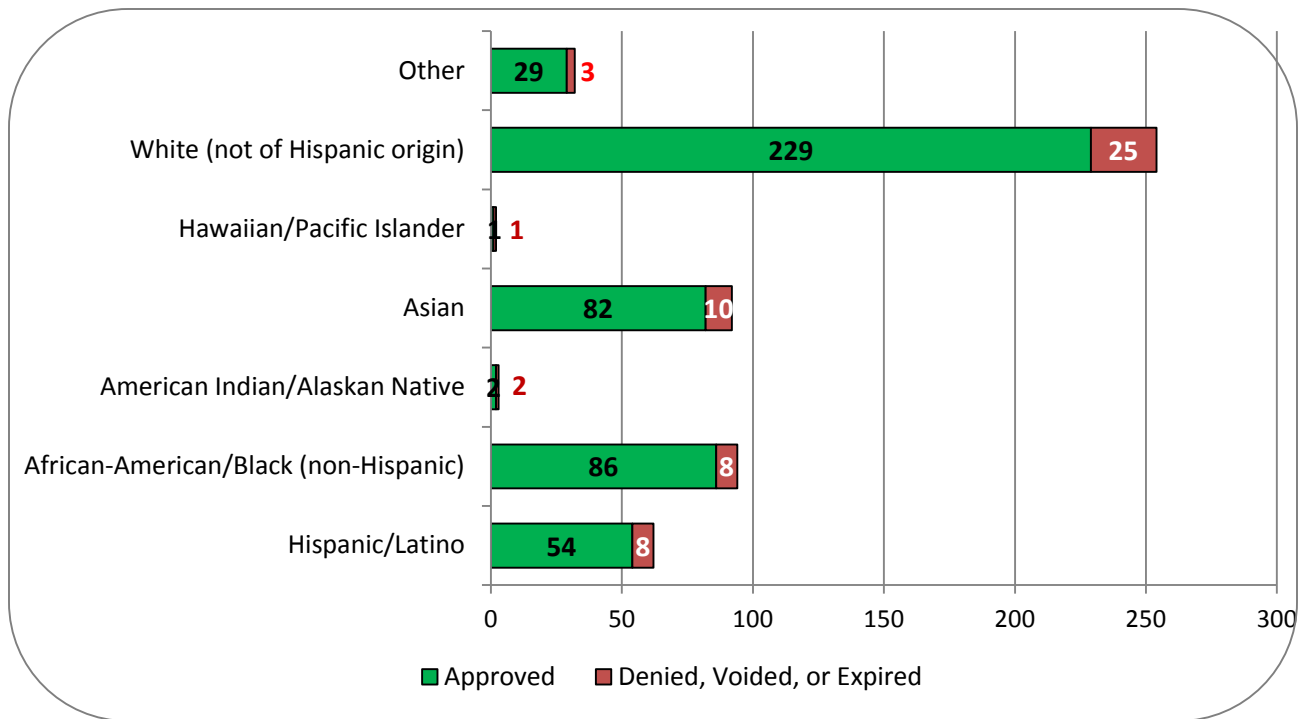
PTCAS offers [fee waivers](#) to financially disadvantaged applicants. The annual APTA fee waiver fund is \$50,000. PTCAS received a total of 501 fee waiver requests in 2014-15, as compared to 467 in 2013-14, 492 in 2012-13, 410 in 2011-12, and 370 waiver requests in 2010-11. PTCAS granted 366 fee waiver requests, as compared to 367 in 2013-14, 340 in 2012-13, 313 in 2011-12 and 265 in 2010-11.

Applicants who were granted a fee waiver applied to an average of **6.3** programs via PTCAS, as compared to 6.3 in 2013-14 and 5.8 in 2012-13. The maximum number of programs applied to by an applicant granted a fee waiver was **36** and the minimum was 1.

PTCAS grants application fee waivers to financially disadvantaged applicants on a first-come, first-serve basis. Fee waiver decisions are based on the applicant's income, or parent's income if claimed as a dependent, as reported on the most recent tax return. PTCAS grants fee waivers to those applicants with earnings that are at or below the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services poverty guidelines. Applicants with approved waivers may apply to a maximum of 1 PTCAS program for free. Applicants who received a PTCAS fee waiver and chose to apply to more than one PTCAS program were responsible for an incremental fee of \$40 for each additional designation. A fee waiver was denied or voided if the applicant did not follow the fee waiver instructions, exceeded the income threshold, or did not submit the PTCAS application within 45 days after the fee waiver was approved.

## Unofficial GRE® Scores

The following tables and figures represent **applicant-reported** Graduate Record Examination (GRE®) percentile scores on the PTCAS application only and do **not** reflect official GRE score reports from the Educational Testing Service (ETS). The mean percentiles reflect the scores for all GRE test-takers for all graduate programs across the United States, as entered by PTCAS applicants from their personal score reports. If multiple unofficial GRE scores were entered by the applicant on the application, only the data for the most recent test date are included in the mean calculation. Applicants without unofficial GRE scores entered on the application are excluded from the table, regardless of whether official GRE scores were received by PTCAS. PTCAS does not verify that applicant-reported GRE scores are accurate or match official GRE scores from ETS.
