

# ALLOPATHIC MEDICAL SCHOOL ADMISSION DATA 2010, 2009, AND 2008 ENTRANCE

The schools listed below are the AMCAS participants which have accepted at least one UCSD graduate in the last three years. UC schools are listed first, then private schools by the most recent year's average admittant's GPA, then non-California public schools in the same order. For each year, the number of UCSD students who were accepted to each school is preceded by the total number of UCSD students who applied to that same school. The MCAT and overall GPA listed is the school's median for all admitted students as published in the *Medical School Admissions Requirements* for the respective year.

These charts are provided to help applicants determine their competitiveness at the U.S. allopathic medical schools. However, admission decisions are not based solely on MCAT and GPA. To help determine where to apply, please see an advisor.
